**1. Call to Order.**

1. September 12, 2022. Ben Zeller, County Judge, called to order the Commissioners Court Regular Term for Monday, September 12, 2022 at 10:00 a.m.

**2. Invocation and Pledges.**

2. September 12, 2022. Judge Ben Zeller opened the meeting with prayer and the reciting of the Pledges of Allegiance of the United States of America and the State of Texas.

**3. Citizens Communication.**

3. September 12, 2022. Judge Ben Zeller opened the meeting to anyone wishing to address general County business which was not on the meeting agenda.

Michael Vonderau, 2204 E. North Street, spoke to the Court about a decision regarding two books that will remain at the Victoria Public Library and if you are age 17 and under, you have to have parental consent to check out books. Mr. Vonderau congratulated the Victoria Police Department and the Sheriff's Office on the 10 DWI's, between the two departments, over the Labor Day holiday.

Harley Fisk, a Victoria County resident, spoke about his background and marginalized groups. Mr. Fisk asked the Court when they start the selection process for new members of the Victoria Library Advisory Board, to consider those individuals who are willing to respect and support all the marginalized groups that make the Victoria area the vibrant community that the Court is elected to serve.

Scott Buchanan with Animal Control updated the Court on the vaccination upon intake program at Victoria Animal Control.

Commissioner Kevin Janak stated the drainage project on Parsons Road is still underway and the road is always closed between 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday, until the project is completed. Also, the remainder of work on Nursery Road between Highway 87 and Highway 77 will now be completed and the road will not be closed.

(1:07:40) Jim Hester, a Victoria County resident, pointed out that people can have misunderstandings about different things and how kids develop differently. He questioned why these inappropriate books would be at the Victoria Public Library and where they are shelved. He stated how children are not ready for these books. Mr. Hester asked the Court as they look at candidates for the library board, it would be good to see how sympathetic they are to the fact of having a variety of kids looking at books and how they might have a completely different impact than what the average kid would have.
